OUR VALUES

- Artistic Roller Skating should be safe, fun and fair
- Children participate to learn, grow and enjoy
- Winning isn't everything — development comes first

AS A PARENT/CARER, I WILL:

1. **Encourage fair play** and help my child learn and follow the rules.
2. **Support effort**, improvement and good performance, not just results.
3. **Never pressure**, force or belittle my child for mistakes or losing.
4. **Model positive behaviour** by applauding fair play, using appropriate language, and showing respect to all.
5. **Promote a safe learning environment** where children enjoy skating and develop positively.
6. **Ensure safeguarding** responsibilities are met, including following GBSA policies.
7. **Let coaches coach** — avoid giving conflicting instructions, interfering with coaching or criticising athletes.
8. **Show support and respect** for all GBSA Officials' and GBSA Board decisions.
9. **Be a role model** for my child – being polite towards skaters, other parents, coaches or officials.
10. **Understand consequences** for misconduct, which may include warnings, suspension or removal from events or GBSA.
