

# GBSA Achievement Levels

Updated: 02<sup>nd</sup> December 2025

Version: 3.0

## General

The GBSA achievement levels are based on RollArt score achievement at GBSA, and internationally selected events judged by a World Skate panel. Athletes will be able to convert their RollArt score from the events into a Level from 1-10. The applicable programme is:

### Free Skating / Pairs

- Free programme for all Promotional events and Primary, Tots and Mini Championship events.
- Total program score for Espoir / Cadet / Youth / Junior / Senior Championship events.

### Solo & Couples Dance / Quartets & Show

- Total program score for all promotional and championship streams

The minimum RollArt score required to achieve each level is as follows:

Achievement Level Requirements Table	
Achievement	RollArt Score
Level 1	5 or more
Level 2	10 or more
Level 3	15 or more
Level 4	20 or more
Level 5	30 or more
Level 6	40 or more
Level 7	50 or more
Level 8	60 or more
Level 9	80 or more
Level 10	100 or more

## How to apply for achievement levels

Applications for Level achievements are to be made within 12 months of the GBSA /International event where the RollArt score was received.

Achievement level applications should be made to the front desk at any GBSA competition. To claim the level, proof via your RollArt PDF showing the minimum score has been reached needs to be provided. Once provided a certificate will be issued to signify the athlete's achievement. Cost of the levels can be found in the event regulations document found on the regulations page of the website.

## Achievement levels added to the members database profile

After each competition, GBSA will provide a list of levels purchased to the Levels/Test Team. They will add the appropriate levels to each member's profile.



Club Admins can then log into the member's profile and navigate to the Achievements tab, where all recorded achievements will be displayed.
