Music Submission

Music Submission for championships is due before event commences. The Heads of Disciplines will communicate further details near to each event.

RollArt Element Submission

Championship. Roll Art element submission will be due before the event commences – The Heads of Disciplines will communicate further details near to each event.

Closing Dates

For both Dance, Figures and Free:

- Competitions - Two calendar months prior to the relevant event unless specified
- Championships & Promo. Nationals - Two calendar months before the relevant event date.
- No late entries will be accepted.

Door/ Spectator Fees

Where possible GBSA prefer card payment, however, please bring alternative methods of payment to the relevant event.

Entry Fees

Entry fees MUST be submitted at the same time as adding entries into the database. Your entry is only valid after you have submitted the payment and the database entry.

- All competitors in GBSA Events must be fully paid up members of the GB Skate Artistic organisation (GBSA).
- Entry Submission for national events and championships should be made via the GBSA Database excluding the Dance national events which will use the spreadsheets on the GBSA website.
- All entries must be received by the office a minimum of two (2) calendar months prior to the date of the event. No late entries will be accepted.
- All Championship entries are controlled by age, including Inline.
- The standard of a skater is on the closing date for entries. Any forth coming tests will not be taken into consideration.
- For Championships - All ages quoted within the structure are “skating ages”. In the case of Dance and Pairs events, the age used for the calculation will be that of the eldest partner. If during the season the partnership splits, then in the following season the respective partners can re- enter at the level at which their age dictates.
- The skating age is the age of a skater is the age the skater is turning in the year of the competition
- The structure allows all athletes to skate one Championship in any one season as set by their age.
- Athletes may skate up categories but once they have competed at that level, they cannot move back down. Athletes must be a skating age of 12 before entering Junior and Senior (including the Solo Dance Championships) in the same year, once a skater has entered a Senior Championship, they cannot go back to any other category in subsequent years.
- In the case of Figure and Free Skating Championships, athletes can enter just one of the disciplines if they wish to-do the single discipline.
- The compulsory figures in GBSA events will be skated on circles of 6metres in diameter and 2.4meters for loops.
- Music for GBSA events must be sent digitally before the event. Clubs must take the appropriate steps to ensure that the music recording levels have been maximised and that the music provided is clear and is the correct version. Full instructions of how to do this will be sent to all clubs – any music not complying with these instructions will be rejected. 1 (one) USB per club should be brought to the venue containing all the club’s music as a backup, the USB should be clearly marked with the club’s name. GBSA can only accept MP3 format.
- The executive Board of GBSA may decide to split the Event by age or standard, if necessary, after the closing date.
- For all Solo Dance Events LADIES STEPS will be skated unless specified.
- There is no restriction on athletes entering both their respective Solo and Couples Dance Events.
- GBSA reserves the right to refuse admission to any GBSA Event.

The Calendar is subject to change, all arrangements should be booked on Flexi as venues and dates can change

RollArt Element Sheet Submissions

For all Rollart events, an element sheet needs to be submitted prior to the event. The closing date for submissions and destination of the submission will be announced prior the events. The element sheets **MUST** be filled out following the correct regulations, failing to do so may result in the athlete being withdraw from the competition.

To access the Element Sheets forms please click [here](#), and select the “Content Sheet” box. Once the above form has been downloaded you will be able to select the discipline you are completing the form for.

- Please ensure that coach’s fill out the forms to correctly represent the content in the athlete’s program(s), failing to correctly input the order of element may result in the athlete being disqualified from the event.
- Please ensure all elements are correctly labelled with the element time, this is required for all decalins. Ensure the timing is marked from the first movement of the athlete.
- For Free skating events, it is mandatory to declare where there is a Lutz presented in the program. This information should be included in the notes section.
- For sequence elements, it is helpful to the panel to include the first element of the sequence, this information can be included in the notes section. For example, “Starting with a bracket”.
- It is advised **NOT** to include the level of the element in the notes section.

1. The section labelled 1 shows where the Element start time should be filled in (Times start from the first movement of the athlete and not the start of the music)
2. The section labelled 2 shows the section where the element code should be declared, it is important that the elements are entered in the correct order to avoid penalisation or withdrawal.
3. The section labelled 3 should be left blank.
4. The section labelled 4 should be used to add any information that may help the technical panel. If a Lutz is within the program, it must be declared in this section.

Once the element sheet is complete, the content must be exported to a PDF. This can be done by clicking the below button:

Once the download as PDF has been selected an option to save the file to your computer is made available, at this point it is important to ensure the document is titled correctly to comply with the events regulations.

An example of the correct title of the element sheet file would be:

DANIEL_WITHERS-SENIORMEN-FREESKATING-LONG-ORDEROFELEMENTS

The element sheet files must be titled in the following format using block capitals:

[FORENAME]_[SURNAME]-[CATEGORY]-[DISCIPLINE]-[SEGMENT]-ORDEROFELEMENTS

- The title must start with the athlete's forename.
- Following an underscore, the athlete's surname should be entered.
- Following a dash, the event category should be entered. For example, SENIORMEN, MINIMEN, 1B.
- Following another dash, the discipline should be entered. For example, FREESKATING, SOLODANCE.
- Following another dash there should be the event segment typed. For example, LONG, FREEDANCE, STYLEDANCE.
- Following a final dash, the title should have "ORDEROFELEMENTS" typed.

Music Submissions

For all events, the program music needs to be submitted prior to the event. The closing date for submissions and destination of the submission will be announced prior the events. The music **MUST** comply with the correct regulations, failing to do so may result in the athlete being withdraw from the competition.

- All music submissions must be in .mp3 format.
- The music must be tested via the coach prior to submitting.
- GBSA is not liable for any incorrect music submissions, if the correct music cannot be provided within 10mins of the athletes scheduled start time, they will be withdrawn from the event.
- Once submitted if the music does not comply with the format or title regulations, it will be rejected.

An example of the correct title of the music file would be **DANIEL_WITHERS-SENIORMEN-FREESKATING-LONG**

The music files tilted in the following format in block capitals:

[FORENAME]_[SURNAME]-[CATEGORY]-[DISCIPLINE]-[SEGMENT]

- The title must start with the athlete's forename.
- Following an underscore, the athlete's surname should be entered.
- Following a dash, the event category should be entered. For example, SENIORMEN, MINIMEN,1B.
- Following another dash, the discipline should be entered. For example, FREESKATING, SOLODANCE.
- Following a final dash there should be the event segment typed. For example, LONG, FREEDANCE, STYLEDANCE.

All clubs must bring with them one (1) USB stick containing all their skater's music, this will only be requested if needed. CDs will no longer be accepted. The stick should be clearly marked with the club's name. The music files should be labelled as stated above.

- Entries will not be accepted unless all information is completed. If any information is missing, they will be rejected.
- Event costs can be found in the 2024 calendar of events.
- The 'closed' white system will be used for all events.
- All Dances will be 2024 steps.
- Depending on entries full sequence dances could be reduced to one sequence.
- Skaters may skate up one standard in solo and team events. On the entry form please mark the skaters name with an * if they are skating up.
- If skaters skate up in Solo events they MUST skate up in Teams or Duo Events also.
- Non-Medallist skaters are not permitted to skate in this event.
- Clubs are no longer permitted to borrow skaters from other clubs to make up Duos or Teams before or during the event. This is to prevent last minute changes to judge's rotas due to club involvement.

Background

All dances listed are TBC – GBSA are waiting for World Skate to issue the 2024 Rollart software to ensure all dances listed are in the system for solo dance.

The aim of the Roller Cup is to create a competitive events structure for non-championship and beginner athletes that will run throughout the year.

It will give non-championship skaters a greater motivation in training and allow coaches and skaters to set goals and objectives for the skating year. It will give beginner skaters and parents an insight into the competitive events.

For 2024 the Roller Cup will be made up of 3 events and a final.

Scoring System

The top 10 skaters in each event will receive points, the points structure will be as follows:

Competition Rules

Entering Rules

1. Entries for the Roller Cup is via the GBSA database, the closing date the **6th of February 2024**.
2. Payment will be made at the time of entry, i.e. £60 for two, £90 for three to GBSA, the cost to enter the Roller Cup is **£30.00 per event**. In the event of the skater withdrawing from any round, there will be no refunds.
3. It is **mandatory** that all skaters commit to entering two (2) Roller Cup competitions. Although they may wish to enter all three (3) rounds. (*Only the two best scores will be totalled and used to make up the top 5 who will reach the final. (Skaters will not be allocated events)*)
4. Skaters will not be allowed to change venues/rounds during the year, they can only attend the rounds that they have asked for by the closing date. If they have not indicated a third round in their entry, then decide they need to earn some more points, the third round will not be possible.
5. Skaters can enter the event associated with their current test level or above. The Dance Club test or Advanced test is accepted.
6. Skaters will be kept at the same standard at entry for all Roller Cup events, even if additional tests are taken during 2024.
7. Events will be split by age were applicable to respect the limits of events, once the splits have been made, they will be the same splits for every round.
8. If a skater decides to leave the Roller Cup structure during the year, the skater and their results will be removed.

General Rules

1. Roller Cup combined Champion 2023 in Non-med, Elementary and Preliminary events must skate up to the next category in 2024.
2. All events, apart from non-medallist will be judged using a closed RollArt System. Non-Medallist will be judged under the white system.
3. No live points will be shown or announced. PDF's will be available at the end of the event.
4. In solo dance events Ladies Solo Dance steps will be skated only.
5. For half sequence dances 4 (four) sequences will be skated. For full sequences dances 2 (two) sequences will be skated.
6. The final will be made up of the top 5 skaters from each event.
7. The final will be a one-off final event, no points from the previous events will be carried over. The event will be a straight competition and not based on points.
8. The final for non-medallist will be judged under RollArt, if the Dance Team agree that the standard is of the correct level for RollArt.
9. Results and league tables will be communicated on GBSA website and GBSA socials post events.

10. The top 3 of each section (dance and free dance) will receive awards as well as the combined winner.
11. If any skaters compete in any category in the 2024 British Championships including Classics and Masters, they will be removed from the Roller Cup.
12. In the event of a draw, **the free dance will be placed higher in the combined result.** The dances for the final will be drawn at round 3.
13. Element sheets and music submissions will be requested for each roller cup round.
14. Only official World Skate PDF documents will be accepted for Free Dance element sheets. Handwritten documents or photos/scans will not be accepted. Please click [here](#) to view the World Skate forms.

The minimum total score needed to be awarded the British Title (Figures & Free)

There is no minimum mark to achieve the British title. If an athlete wins the championship event, they are crowned British champion for that year.

Championship Entry Requirements (Figures & Free)

There's no entry requirement for the championship events. It should be noted that championship events run under World Skate age categories and coaches are expected to consider if an athlete is appropriate for that event.

If GBSA feels that coaches are entering athletes into inappropriate categories GBSA has the power to remove the coach's accreditation and/or athlete from the category.

Promotional events – General

General

GBSA promotional events will be governed by the World Skate basic promotional regulations. Please note that all World Skate rules apart from age regulations or explicitly mentioned rule changes in GBSA documentation will be followed for promotional events. Please view the World Skate (2024) promotions rules [here](#).

If athletes are not competing within championship categories, GB promotional levels that are aligned to the World Skate basic levels are used. GBSA promotional events will run these categories under ability rather than age.

Each category will be judged under World Skate rules for basic Tots to Senior for free skating. For figure events, the figures will be mapped to the corresponding World Skate figure group and GBSA test level.

Promotional category entry requirements

There are no minimum entry requirements for promotional events. Once an athlete has been entered to compete at a promotional level, they must compete at that level for all GBSA promotional events within that season. If an athlete places first in any of the GBSA promotional events (and there are more than 3 competitors), then the athlete must compete at a higher level in the following season. This includes winners' of 2023 events, who must compete at a higher level in 2024.

Athletes who finish in first, second and third places at the Roller Cup Final events cannot compete at a lower level the following season (if there are more than 3 competitors in the category).

If any athlete wins the highest promotional category the coach is advised to start looking at moving the athlete into the championships categories although this is not required, and they are permitted to compete in the highest promotional level during the next season, but the athlete is not permitted to move to a lower category.

Invited athletes.

Free skating

Only promotional finalists will receive invitations to the Roller Cup Finals. To become a finalist, an athlete must secure a placement within the top 8 of their respective categories in the Roller Cup Rankings. In free skating, some events may be split by age, depending on entry numbers. If this is the case, the age categories will be combined into one category at the final. This means there will be one ranking per level; for example, one ranking for Level 1A, Level 1B, Level 1C, Level 2, and Level 3. **If the category is seen to be too large, then the F&F team by split by age during the final.**

The ranking will be determined by the ~~total score obtained by the athlete throughout the season~~, highest total score being considered. For example, if an athlete scores 10 points at the Spring Roller Cup and 12 points at the Summer Roller Cup, ~~their total points would be 22 points~~, their highest score would be 12 points and this score will determine the athlete's ranking for that season, and the top 8 athletes will be invited to the final.

Figures

Only promotional finalists will be invited to the Roller Cup Finals. To become a finalist, an athlete must place within the top 8 of their categories in the Roller Cup Rankings. Some figure categories may be split by age, depending on entry numbers. If this occurs, the remaining figure Roller Cup events for that year will be split into the same categories. Each of these categories will then have an event held at the Roller Cup finals. For example, if Level 1A is split into "1A 12 and under" and "1A 13 and over," the same split will be applied at all the Roller Cup events that year, and both categories will be run at the Roller Cup final.

Points will be earned based on placements at the Roller Cup events. Each placement will be allocated points, ~~and the total number of points will determine the athlete's placement~~ the athlete's highest placement within that season will be used to determine the athlete's points. The top 8 ranking athletes after the Summer Roller Cup will be invited to the Roller Cup finals. For example, if an athlete places 5th at the Spring Roller Cup event (380 points) and 3rd at the Summer Roller Cup event (390 points), ~~their total points would be 770~~, their ranking points would be 390. In the event of a tie for 8th place, both 8th and 9th place will be invited to the final.

- The foot is already drawn according to the above grid for levels one to four.
- Where relevant the foot will be drawn 3 weeks prior to the event.
- Events will be judged using the closed white system.
- Promotional categories will run events with Men and Ladies combined.
- Any figure circles within the athlete's competition half (Rink A or Rink B) can be used.
